

**HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WORK SESSION MEETING OF THE
CLAYTON TOWN COUNCIL
JUNE 21, 2010**

All Council members voted in favor of approving the following action agenda items:

- Draft minutes from the June 7, 2010, regular meeting and draft minutes from the June 7, 2010, closed session meeting.

Moved to the consent agenda for the July 19, 2010, meeting:

- Final acceptance for Sam's Creek Sanitary Sewer Interceptor.

Acted on items on the regular agenda:

- The following new Town of Clayton employees was introduced:
 - Carlos Terry, Meter Reader
- All Council members received presentation on human trafficking by representatives of Soroptimist.
- All Council members voted in favor of suspending the rules in order to take action during the work session.
- All Council members discussed bid opening of the "Think Clayton" Public Square project. All Council members voted in favor of approving the bid from ValleyCrest Landscape Development and that the Town Manager follow-up on the bench alternate.
- All Council members discussed and voted in favor of amending the Town's Comprehensive List of Fees and Charges to include as a Privilege License Fee: Cyber Gaming Establishments (aka Internet Cafes) with a flat fee of \$2,500 per business and a fee of \$350 per machine.
- All Council members voted in favor of adopting the fiscal year 2010-2011 budget as presented.
- Status of Riverwood Athletic Club streets – included for TRACKING PURPOSES ONLY.
- All Council members received as information the Planning Board Highlights of the May 2010 meeting.
- All Council members voted in favor of adjourning at 8:29 PM.
