According to Section 155.710(I)(2) of the Town of Clayton Unified Development Code, a Conditional Use Permit is required when a substantial deviation is made to an existing approved Conditional Use Permit.

All meetings of the Clayton Board of Adjustment are public meetings and citizens are invited to attend. Evidentiary hearings may be scheduled during a public meeting:

- Evidentiary hearing, also known as quasi-judicial hearing, occurs when an agenda item has been advertised and noticed according to the law; however, the Board of Adjustment acts like a court of law. During an evidentiary hearing, the Board of Adjustment receives only sworn testimony and other credible evidence. In addition, the Board of Adjustment must make findings of fact based upon the evidence presented. Citizens may give testimony in an evidentiary hearing after they have taken an oath.
