WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY

The Town of Clayton is currently constructing a new water reclamation facility to treat wastewater for the residents of Clayton. This facility will be completed mid-to-late 2025 and will replace the aging existing plant providing additional treatment capacity of 6 million gallons per day and growth potential of 10 million gallons per day.

The plant is currently under construction by Thales Construction and is located at 1689 N. O'Neil Street.

Usage and Weather Tracker




See how the weather effects your monthly usage and how you can conserve and save during peak seasons.


Your Personalized Dashboard
