

Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that the Town Council of the Town of Clayton will hold a public hearing on Monday, February 5, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in the Clayton Town Hall Council Meeting Room, 111 East Second Street, Clayton, NC.

The purpose of the public hearing is to receive public comment on the proposed renaming of two public roads as follows: (1) the current NC Hwy 42 from US 70 BUS to the extent of the jurisdiction of the Town of Clayton to be renamed as a result of the NC Department of Transportation's NC Hwy 36 conversion project will be named and known as VETERAN'S PARKWAY; and (2) the current US 70 BUS from the Wake/Johnston County line on the west of Clayton to the US 70 and US 70 BUS Interchange on the east of Clayton, to the extent the same is within the jurisdiction of the Town of Clayton, shall be renamed and known as CLAYTON BOULEVARD.

The new road names are intended to enhance recognition, public safety and emergency response.

The public may obtain additional information and maps from the NC Department of Transportation, the Johnston County Planning and Zoning Department or the Office of the Town Clerk for the Town of Clayton between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Please be advised that the Town Council may choose to take action on this matter immediately following the public hearing.
