

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
BEFORE THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CLAYTON
FOR APPROVAL OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN OCCUPANCY TAX IN THE TOWN
LIMITS OF CLAYTON

WHEREAS, Session Law 2023, Senate Bill 154, as ratified on the 25th day of October 2023, authorizes the Town of Clayton to create a taxing district located inside the incorporated area only located within Johnston County known as “Clayton District C”, (“District”), and

WHEREAS, Town of Clayton Town Council wishes to establish a 2% Occupancy Tax of the gross receipts derived from the rental of any room, lodging, or accommodations furnished by a hotel, motel, inn, tourist camp, or similar place within the District that is subject to sales tax imposed by the State under G.S. 105-164.4(a)(3), and

WHEREAS, an occupancy tax enacted by the Town Council shall be levied, administered, collected, and repealed as provided in G.S. 160A-215.

THEREFORE, NOTICE is hereby given that the Town Council of the Town of Clayton will hold a public hearing on the approval of the establishment of an occupancy tax in the town limits of the Town of Clayton at its regular meeting on May 6, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at 111 East Second Street, Clayton, North Carolina.

All interested citizens are invited to appear and be heard.
