Look for additional artwork and art opportunities around Clayton. Visit the following locations, as well as local businesses to view exhibits, listen to live music, and see why Clayton is highly regarded as an arts community.

### 1 The Clayton Center

- Lobby Gallery features monthly art exhibits curated by the nonprofit Clayton Visual Arts, Inc.
- Permanent art installation: "Clayton Patchwork," a mural by local artist Dorothy Dembowski
- Historic Auditorium and Conference Center presenting theater, dance, and musical performances

### 2 Hocutt-Ellington Memorial Library

- Permanent art installation: "True Colors," a mural depicting the life and times of Clayton by local illustrators Jim and Ginny Brown
- Rotating monthly art displays featuring local artists

### 3 Main Street Community Garden

- Beautiful, art-filled garden maintained by volunteers and business partners, free and open to explore

### 4 Sam's Branch Greenway

- Permanent art installation: butterfly garden art by local artist Georges Le Chevallier
- Rotating outdoor art created by local students, families, and residents

### 5 Town Hall Veterans Memorial

- Our "Tribute to Veterans" sculpture serves as the centerpiece of the Veterans Memorial Reflection Wall at Clayton Town Hall as a reminder of the sacrifices of all our service members and their families. "All gave some, Some gave all."


