

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for construction of the **Central Pump Station Decommissioning Gravity Sewer** will be received by the Town of Clayton, NC (Owner) in the Training Room located at the Clayton Operations Center, 653 Highway 42 West, Clayton, NC 27520 until **1:00 pm, local time, on Wednesday, April 25, 2018.** Any Bids received after the specified time will not be considered.

Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project contemplated consists of the following major Work items:

- Approximately 600 linear feet (LF) of 8-inch and 1,700 LF of gravity wastewater line from the Town of Clayton's existing sanitary sewer Central Pump Station to the existing gravity sewer line north of the Town's Sam's Branch Interceptor, connection to the existing sanitary collection system, and appurtenant Work, including:
 - 250 linear feet of 8-inch polyvinyl chloride (PVC) gravity wastewater line,
 - 350 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron gravity wastewater line,
 - 1350 linear feet of 10-inch polyvinyl chloride (PVC) gravity wastewater line,
 - 350 linear feet of 10-inch ductile iron gravity wastewater line.
- Abandonment of the existing approximately 200,000 gallons per day capacity sanitary sewer Central Pump Station, related selective demolition, salvage and return of pump station equipment to the Owner, and appurtenant Work.

The Work shall be completed in all respects within 180 calendar days from the Contract start date specified in the Notice to Proceed.

Bidding Documents are also available free of charge on compact disc in secured portable document format (PDF). Return of the documents is not required, and amount paid for the documents is nonrefundable.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed Bid Form and accompanied by Bid security as prescribed in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish the additional bond(s) and insurance prescribed in the Bidding Documents.

In order to perform public work, the Successful Bidder and Subcontractors shall hold such licenses as required by North Carolina Statutes, and federal and local Laws and Regulations. Bidder must submit evidence of license with its Bid. No Bid will be considered without such evidence.

There will be no pre-bid conference. Questions will be accepted up to 5:00 pm on Friday, April 20th, 2018.

Bidders shall be required to submit with their Bids affidavits of “Good Faith Efforts” in the recruitment of Minority Businesses. Owner is an Equal Opportunity Employer and does not discriminate. Small, minority and woman-owned businesses and labor surplus area firms are encouraged to submit bids.

This project will be partially funded with Federal funds from the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration and therefore is subject to the Federal laws and regulations associated with that program.

Owner’s right is reserved to reject all Bids or any Bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Bidding Documents.
