Separate sealed bids for the construction of the Little Creek Outfall Line Replacement will be received at the office of the Town Engineer, 111 East Second Street, Clayton, NC 27520 at until 2:00 PM local time on January 28, 2021, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read in the Lobby of the Town Hall. Please note the following:

- Entrance to Town Hall is only from the 2nd Street entrance.
- The parking lot at the Town Hall is under renovation and will be closed. As such, parking may be difficult in the area. Please provide adequate time for parking on arrival for the Bid. Parking options include angled parking outside Town Hall, Town Square parking lot, on-street parking, and Lot between Clayton Center and Horne Memorial United Methodist Church.

COVID 19 Requirements: Only one representative will be allowed in the lobby per Bidder. Social distancing and masks will be required for entrance to the Town Hall.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 2:00 pm local time on January 14, 2021 at the Clayton Wastewater Treatment Plant, 2000 Durham Street, Clayton, NC. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory. The pre-bid conference will be held outside. As such, the meeting date may have to change for inclement weather. Notification will be submitted to plan holders by phone and email to the contact person of record.

The Project consists of constructing the following major items:

1. Sanitary Sewer System Improvements
 - a. 215 lf of 8-inch PVC gravity sewer main.
 - b. 270 lf of 10-inch PVC gravity sewer main.
 - c. 135 lf of 12-inch PVC gravity sewer main.
 - d. 1,390 lf of 24-inch PVC gravity sewer main.
 - e. 490 lf of 24-inch DI gravity sewer main
 - f. 135 lf of 30-inch gravity sewer main.
 - g. 120 lf of 36-inch steel casing by bore & jack with 24-inch DI
 - h. 70 lf of 36-inch steel casing by open cut with 24-inch DI
 - i. Abandonment of 1,700 ft of existing 18-inch sewer
 - j. By-pass Pumping

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

Complete Bidding Documents may be obtained at the Issuing Office of the Engineer upon submitting a non-refundable fee in the amount of \$200.00 for each set of document.

With request for Bidding Documents supply the following information: Company name, contact person and email, street address, and phone and fax numbers for Bidding office; N. C. contractor's license with limitation and classification; indicate if the firm will be a Bidder, Supplier or Sub-Contractor.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office and Owner's office on Mondays through Fridays during normal business hours and at:

Bidders will be required to show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bidding Documents as required by North Carolina General Statute, Chapter 87 and the Instructions to Bidders. Bid Security in the amount of five percent of the Bid must accompany each Bid and shall be subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall be required to submit with their Bids affidavits of "Good Faith Efforts" in the recruitment of Minority Businesses.

The Owner is an Equal Opportunity Employer and encourages bidding by small, minority and female contractors and does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status. Bids from qualified disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) are encouraged.
