The Town of Clayton is seeking interested citizens to serve on various advisory boards, which provide support and advice to the Town Council. Most boards meet monthly and are a three-year commitment.

### **Board of Adjustment      5 Vacancies & 2 Alternates**

**(3- In Town) (2- ETJ)      Alternates (1-In Town) (1-ETJ)**

The Board of Adjustment serves to interpret the Town's ordinances and polices for unique situations or special cases. The Board also decides whether to grant variances – deviations from what the Town's ordinances allow. The Board is a "quasi-judicial" board, which means the Board's power is above that of the code enforcement officer, but below that of the court system.

The Town Council may, in its discretion, appoint and provide compensation for two alternate members to serve on the Board of Adjustment in the absence of any regular member. One alternate member shall be from the town and one alternate member shall be from the ETJ.

Alternate members shall be appointed for the same term, at the same time, and in the same manner as regular members.

Each alternate member, while attending any regular or special meeting and serving in the absence of any regular member, shall have and may exercise all the powers and duties of a regular member.

**Meetings are held the third Wednesday of the month at 6:00 PM in the Town Council Chambers.**
