

**TOWN OF CLAYTON
PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, damage resulting from the effects of Hurricane Dorian are expected and this has given rise to a state of emergency within the Town of Clayton; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Town of Clayton is authorized, pursuant Chapter 93, Section 93.02, of the Clayton Town Code of Ordinances, to issue proclamations of emergency whenever times of public disaster or crisis exist; and

WHEREAS, the following restrictions and prohibitions shall be observed during the proclaimed emergency:

- Of movements of people in public places;
- Of the operation of offices, business establishments, and other places to or from which people may travel or at which they may congregate;
- Upon the possession, transportation, sale, purchase, and consumption of alcoholic beverages;
- Upon the possession, transportation, sale, purchase, storage, and use of dangerous weapons and substances, and gasoline; and
- Upon other activities or conditions the control of which may be reasonably necessary to maintain order and protect lives or property during the state of emergency.


